BURSARY POLICY

This policy will not apply to persons receiving fee waivers.
The Union may disperse up to 10 - \$1,000.00 bursaries semi-annually.

1. Eligibility:

- Beginning January 1, 2007, the bursary program is open to CUPE 4627 members and their dependants attending or planning to attend a post-secondary educational institution.
- Only one application per member per calendar year will be considered.
- Applicants for bursaries are awarded according to the member's seniority.
- An applicant for bursary must not receive a bursary 2 years in succession unless there are no other eligible applicants.

2. Procedures:

- The Executive will review applications(s) and make the final selection.
- Upon completion of the course(s)/program a copy of the transcript will be supplied to the Secretary-Treasurer for recording in the books.
- Voluntary non-attendance or withdrawal will disqualify the member from future receipt of bursary money until the Union is reimbursed for the bursary received.
- Cut off dates for applications are June 1st and Dec 1st of each calendar year.

3. Payment:

- A Union Bursary is \$1,000.
